AFL	135-185M X 110-155M	Centre circles: 3m (inner) / 10m (outer) radius • Goal square: 9m × 6.4m • 50m arc from goal line.	7-10 days
Soccer	100-110m X 64-75m	Penalty area: 40.3m × 16.5m • Goal area: 18.3m × 5.5m • Centre circle: 9.15m radius • Penalty spot: 11m	7-14 days
Rugby League	100m x 68m	In-goal: 6–11m deep • 10m lines from halfway • 20m lines from try lines • Goal posts: 5.5m apart	7-14 days
Rugby Union	100m x 70m max	In-goal: 10–22m deep • 22m lines • 10m lines • Halfway line • Goal posts: 5.6m apart	7-14 days
Touch Football	70m x 50m	Dimensions vary by competition level — always check with local association for specific requirements	10-14 days

ESSENTIAL TIPS

- 1 String lines first** - non-negotiable for runs over 10m.
- 2 Mow before marking** - mark within 24 hrs of cut.
- 3 Light touch-ups** - avoid heavy paint build-up.
- 4 Multi-code sequence** - boundary first, internals last.

TURF TYPE NOTES

Couch

Fine texture holds edges well. Apply lighter coats

Kikuyu

Fast vertical growth. More frequent touch-ups needed.

Cool-Season

Absorbs faster. Watch dormant patches for build-up.

MARKING CONDITIONS

✓ IDEAL

Moderate moisture, 15–25°C, low wind, early AM or late PM.

⚠ CAUTION

Surface temp 25–35°C, light dew, weather change approaching.

✗ AVOID

Saturated surface, >35°C, heavy dew, rain imminent, strong wind.
